- April 1, 2022: Osaka Metropolitan University (OMU) opened its doors as a new public university
- OMU is created through the merger of Osaka City University (1880-) and Osaka Prefecture University (1883-)

 - 1,480 graduate students










International Students



We have approximately *16,000* students including *600* International students from *29* countries. And we have worldwide academic partners. Totally 233 institutions in 42 countries and regions

Requirements

- MoU is necessary for the students mobility .
- Duration: One semester or One full year for credit earning program
 Short term is acceptable for non-credit earning program
- Language proficiency
 - **For undergraduates** we would require a reasonable level of Japanese language proficiency, for example JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) N2 level or equivalent to N2 level, because in the undergraduate course almost all the classes are conducted in Japanese.
 - For postgraduates who don't need to earn credits Japanese language proficiency is not mandatory. It may depend on their host professor. If they agree to supervise the exchange students in English, we don't require them Japanese language proficiency.

International House "I-wing Nakamozu"

- ◆International students live in the campus with Japanese students.
- ◆ Monthly rent: JPY37,800
- ◆ 20 units with 80 private rooms











Accommodation for International Students

Orion International House

- Private room with bath and toilet
- Shared kitchen
- Monthly rent: JPY33,000 (water and Wi-Fi charge included)
- Managed by Osaka Prefecture
 International students belonging to the school in Osaka can apply.

The numbers of the accommodations we can provide is quite limited. In case they are all full, we may ask you to find private apartments with the help from your host professor. We also will support you in this regards.
