TEMPORAL RESIDENCE PROCEDURES AND ASSISTANCE

In order to be able to study in Croatia the easiest way is to apply for a temporary residence permit and not for a visa. In order to apply students will need:

- 2 color photographs, 35 x 45 mm;
- copy of a valid travel document;
- proof of ensured dwelling;
- proof of ensured health insurance;
- proof of ensured means of subsistence in compliance with the Regulation on the method of calculation and amount of means of subsistence for aliens in the Republic of Croatia;
- proof of the reasons for temporary stay (Acceptance letter)

The mentioned documents should be translated into Croatian and delivered to a Croatian embassy.

ERASMUS students can do these procedures in Croatia, it is recommended for the rest to do it in their home countries.
