

We offer incoming exchange/visiting students a variety of courses that cover different disciplines. The students are allowed to choose courses across all schools (except School of Medicine and School of Music) if they meet the pre-requisites and the space allows. Undergraduate courses are not offered to postgraduates and vice versa.

The incoming exchange/visiting students will receive an updated list of courses with outlines in July and apply for courses online in August if the students study with us in the Fall term, in November and in December if in the Spring term.

CUHK-Shenzhen uses a credit unit system. Criteria of assessment may include any one or a combination of the following: attendance, class work, written work, laboratory work, fieldwork, research papers, tests, examinations, and/or any other assessment.





Admission Requirements

- Undergraduate students should have completed at least two academic terms of university studies. Postgraduate students should have a recognised bachelor's degree or equivalent and currently enroll in a postgraduate programme at a partner university.
- Grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (B average or above, or equivalent). Applications with a slightly lower GPA will be carefully assessed.
- If students are from institutions where English is not the primary language of instruction, they should have a minimum TOEFL score of 530 (paper-based) / 71 (internet-based) or IELTS 6.0 or equivalent.

Application Procedures



Accommodation

CUHK-Shenzhen adopts a collegiate system. Colleges are social communities with their own dormitories, dining halls, gyms, music studio, dance room and other facilities. All students will be assigned to different colleges so that students with different academic and cultural backgrounds will enjoy close interaction with teachers and grow up with peers at colleges. A tutor will be arranged in each floor and a warden in each block for caring students.

On-campus accommodation is available to incoming exchange/visiting students but cannot be guaranteed due to limited capacities.




International students are required to purchase adequate health and travel insurance covering the period of their stay in China. Students cannot register at CUHK-Shenzhen without proof of sufficient health and travel insurance cover.

If the students plan to travel outside the Chinese mainland during the study, their insurance should cover for times and places they are visiting.

Visa & Residence Permit

Visa

International students should apply for “X” (study) visa at your local Chinese Embassy or Consulate-General with the required documents.

X1 visa is issued to those who intend to study for a period of more than 180 days.

X2 visa is issued to those who intend to study for a period of no more than 180 days (including 180 days).

The X visa is for single entry

If international students would like to visit outside the Chinese mainland during their study at CUHK-Shenzhen, they need to apply for a Residence Permit within 30 days upon arrival in China to obtain multiple entries qualification. Detailed information about the application procedure of Residence Permit will be provided after their arrival.

Residence Permit

The residence permit for study is issued to persons who pursue long-term (exceeding 180 days) studies in China.

Please note

- For the latest information regarding visa application, please contact your nearest Embassy/Consulate of China.
 - After students arrive in the Chinese mainland, the X visa for single entry cannot allow students to exit and re-enter the Chinese mainland. Students must stay in the Chinese mainland until the Residence Permit is granted.

Tuition

- Exchange students shall pay tuition fees to their home institutions.
- Visiting students shall pay tuition fees to CUHK-Shenzhen. Tuition fees will be charged according to the amount of credit units taken at CUHK-Shenzhen. The calculation is based on the prevailing tuition level and subject to review from time to time.

Housing

4-bed dormitory

- CNY600/student/term
- CNY1,200/student/academic year
- CNY800/student (refundable if there is no damage to the room when the students check out)

Health Check

CNY500-800

Residence Permit Application

- CNY400/term
- CNY800/academic year

Daily Cost
