

- Conditions to attend courses in English: You must provide an official
 English test at the time of application

- Please note that places are limited and that there is no guarantee that all students who speak French will be able to take courses in English. Groups are formed at the beginning of the academic year.

FRENCH TEST ACCEPTED FOR THE APPLICATION:

TCF B2 or DELF B2

WARNING: To obtain the Master in Management degree, you must pass the <u>TOEIC</u> test with a minimum score of 790. Possibility to take the TOEIC test at CSB (1 free test)

No other test will be accepted by the graduation jury.



Work-study program

- The work study program is a training system that allows students to alternate periods of theoretical learning at the School and professional immersion in a company.
- This system exists in the 3rd year of our Bachelor programs and in the Master in Management program, during the two years of the Master's program or only in the final year.
- Since September 2022, new arrivals to France can sign a work-study contract. However, in order to benefit from the help and expertise of our Corporate Relations Department, we ask that students be present at the School at the time of the research (previous year)
- Students can nevertheless do their own research
- In order to sign a work-study contract with our school, it is mandatory to provide a French test with a minimum score of B2 (no exceptions can be accepted)
- New students wishing to do a work-study program have until June 30th before the beginning of the school year to find their company.

Payment: Deposit of 3500€ to be paid upon receipt of the pre-admission letter

Balance of tuition fees to be paid before December 31 The 3500€ deposit will be refunded only in case of visa refusal (minus 250€ administrative fees)


Visa Application

Procedure to complete:

- Where to apply: https://www.campusfrance.org/en (if your country is concerned by the EEF procedure)
- When to Apply: At least 2 months before your intended departure date to avoid any last-minute issues.
- Fast-Track Procedure: Students participating in exchange programs may benefit from an expedited process.


Upon Arrival in France:

- You will need to validate your visa. This is a simplified online process, which must be completed as soon as you have a permanent address in France.
- Documents Required for Validation:
 - Passport & Visa
 - Bank Card (for online validation fees)

Student life



- Dynamic Student Life: Vibrant activities and associations aimed at developing autonomy and soft skills.
- International Student Orientation: An online session held one month before arrival in France, followed by a Welcome Session with Q&A, ice-breaking activities, and a campus tour right before classes begin.
- Alumni Network: A strong professional network with monthly alumni afterworks to maintain connections.
- Well-being Focused: The campus emphasizes student well-being through various initiatives.
- Active Sports Life: Participate in sports like football, rugby, and more, with teams recognized as national champions.
- **Graduation Ceremony:** A memorable milestone, marking the end of the student journey.



Cost of living

- Clermont offers an affordable cost of living compared to larger cities in France, making it an ideal student city. On average, students can expect to spend around €680 to €800 per month depending on their lifestyle and accommodation choices.
 - Accommodation: Student housing or shared apartments typically range from €400 to €550 per month.
 - Groceries: A monthly budget of €150 to €200 is sufficient for basic groceries.
 - Transportation: Public transport is affordable, with a student pass costing approximately €30 per month.
 - Other Expenses: Entertainment, dining out, and personal expenses can vary, but students can expect to spend around €100 to €150 monthly.
- The first month, students will have additional expenses (rent deposit, electricity, gas, telephone,...)
- Students must pay the CVEC Contribution Vie Étudiante et de Campus

Accommodation

 - Moversia Agency: historical partner of the School that offers an apartment search service in the city, at a distance and according to your criteria plus an administrative support service
 Fee-based service
 - The School has partnerships with several student residences in the city: List avalable in the guide for international students
 - Several classified ad sites (the best known: Leboncoin.fr)
- WARNING: To rent an apartment you must have a guarantor in France (some landlords accept guarantors abroad) or pay several months' rent in advance or take out the "Visale" or "Garantme" guarantee.
- Make sure to start your research and reservation much in advance and be careful of scams!
