



Student Housing Information


Over 95% of students live in shared apartments.





Rent & Utilities


- 20% of students pay less than \$1000/month.
- Over 70% of students spend less than \$1500/month on housing.






Popular Areas of Residence

Roosevelt Island and Manhattan are the most popular areas.










Typical Commuting Time to School
