# WHAT CLASSES CAN I TAKE?

## DIVERSE BUSINESS CURRICULUM

Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Public Policy, Entrepreneurial Studies, Finance, Law, History and Communication, Marketing, and many more!

## ELECTIVE COURSES

Incoming Exchange students are able to take electives, but not "core" courses. Students should also note prerequisite requirements for all classes as there is a process for getting into these courses.

## FULL COURSE LOAD

The minimum full-time course load requirement is 12 Ross credits. The maximum is 18 credits and students average taking 15 credits per semester.

# ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

- English

## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

The University of Michigan requires students to have demonstrated proficiency in English. Minimum requirements as suggested by the University are:

- IELTS: 6.5-7.0 range
- TOEFL (PBT): 600
- TOEFL (IBT): 100

**Foreign language courses are available if allowed by your home institution**



- Personal expenses: \$3,000


