In 2015 about the 12% of students regularly enrolled are involved in mobility programs. Incoming students come from more than 50 countries and we have more than 80 International partners. About the 25% of our outgoing students continue the exchange period with the internship abroad and about the 20% of incoming students are supported to find an internship into Italian companies.






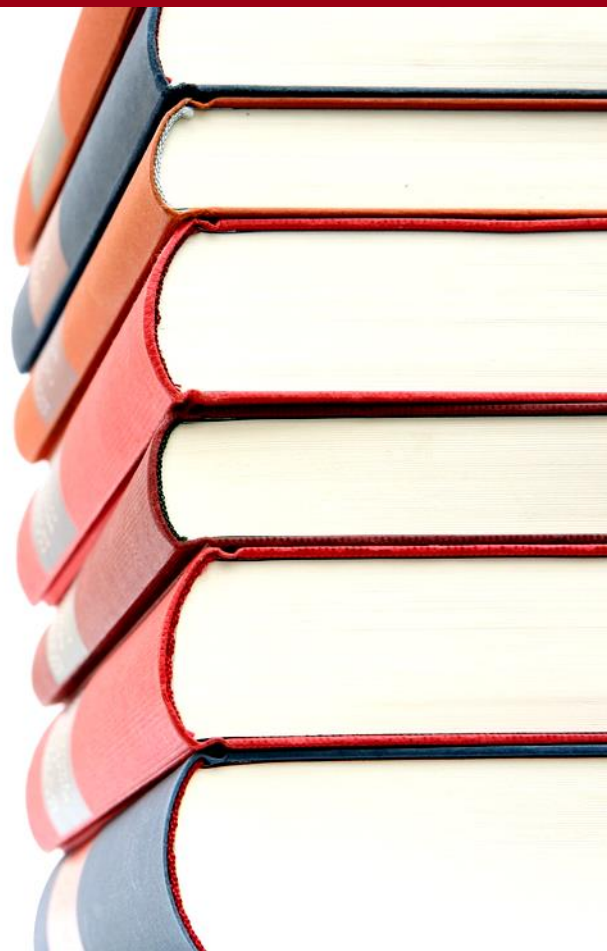
1 three-year undergraduate program (BACHELOR OF COMMERCE):

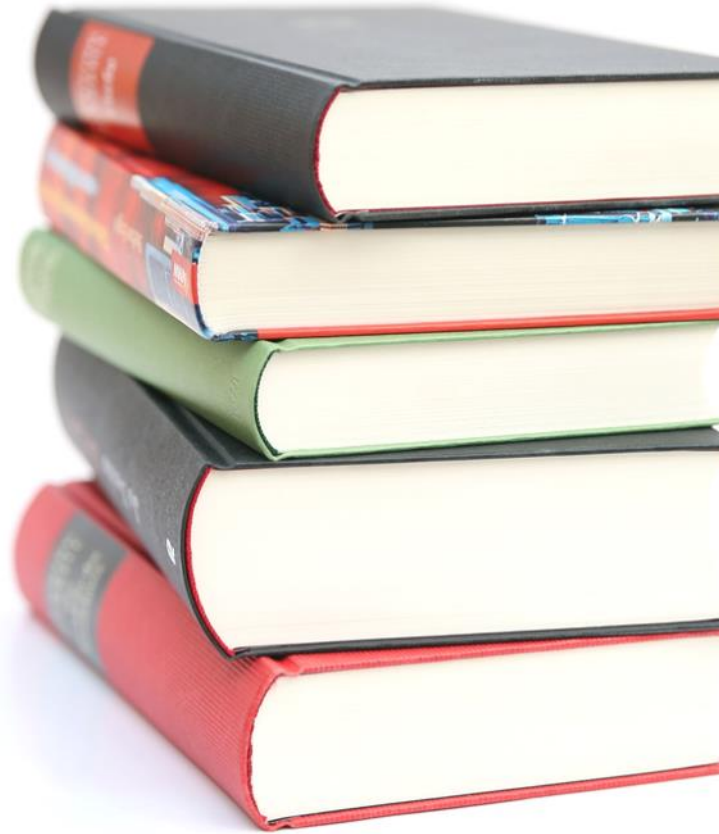

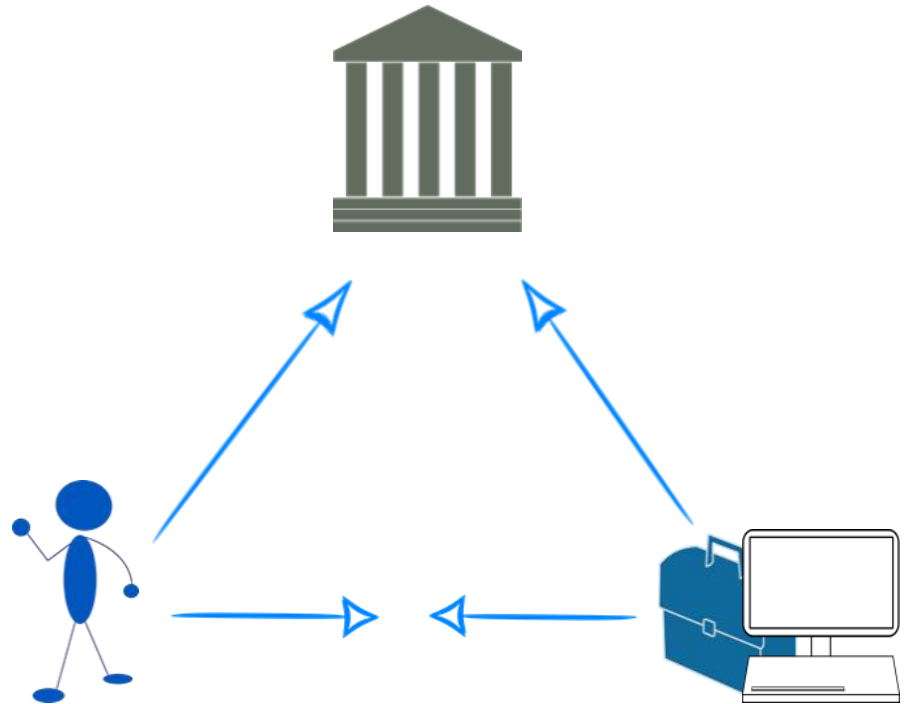

- Cappella degli Scrovegni

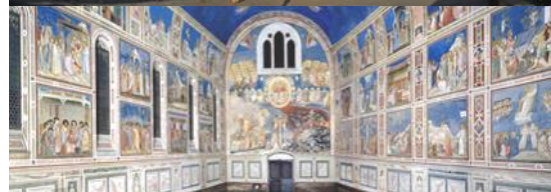
