- **One topic DOES NOT NECESSARILY imply only one dissertation:**
a single topic can be developed by multiple students

Every professor has a *given number of students* to supervise depending on:

- his/her academic activities
- his/her employment relationship with the University
- his/her Department

Select the thesis 1/2



- **BEFORE** the selection procedure opens:
 - 1. Read carefully all the topics**
 - 2. Contact the professors** (it is strongly suggested!) in order to make a careful choice
- The selection procedure will open at the **beginning of March 2026**



These dates applies only for students **enrolled in 2024/25**

Select the thesis 2/2



- You can select a topic **only** if you have **70 CFU**
- Note that:
 - You will be required to **rank** your first **3 choices (max)**
 - For every choice, you must fill in a **brief form** indicating:
 - Reasons for choosing the topic (BE SMART!)
 - Career information

After your selection

- After you have done your selection, your first choice supervisor receives an email with your details.
- The Professor has **15 days** to:
APPROVE YOUR REQUEST **OR** **EXPRESS A MOTIVATED REJECTION**

What are the 15 days for?

Usually (but it is not mandatory) professors use these days for a short selection procedure (e.g. interviews).

Can my request be rejected?

Yes, the Professor may reject your request ... in two cases:

- The supervisor receives a number of requests higher than his/her maximum threshold
- The student does not meet the minimum skills requirements to elaborate the topic



In case your first choice is rejected...

The previous procedure will be automatically activated
for your **second** (and, eventually, **third**) **choice**.

After the approval



Within a **maximum of 30 days** after approval, the student
must contact the Professor to start the project.

Formatting your document

- Layout (line spacing, margins, font)
- Declaration of authenticity (Anti-Plagiarism Rules)
- Confidentiality commitment
- Cover page



Anti-Plagiarism Rules and Declaration of Authenticity



Anti-plagiarism rules

With the Anti-Plagiarism rules, the Department intends to promote and ensure the students' duty to write their thesis in full respect of copyright and intellectual property.

Declaration of Authenticity

On the page following the title page of the thesis, must be inserted the **“Declaration of Authenticity”** signed by the candidate, in the absence of which the Supervisor cannot, under any circumstances, approve the paper which cannot, therefore, be submitted for the degree examination.

Thesis evaluation (/110)

- **7/110**: maximum score that can be awarded to the final dissertation
- the evaluation will take into account the quality and originality of the thesis, as well as its presentation and discussion
- **Additional points**:
 - **3/110**: graduation in July or October
 - **2/110**: graduation in December
 - **1/110**: graduation in March
- **cum Laude** can be awarded only if:
 - after the discussion the evaluation is the maximum (**7/110**)
 - final grade is not less than 105/110 (including the additional points)
 - upon the recommendation of the Co-Examiner
 - by unanimous decision of the Committee

Application for graduation via Uniweb

- In addition to the previously described procedure, you must fill in an **Application for Graduation** early in the semester in which you intend to graduate.
- Applications for Graduation may be submitted electronically via **Uniweb**.
- Each electronic Application for Graduation will result in a € 16.00 non-refundable charge on your student's bill.

Tips - How to Relate to Your (Potential) Supervisor (1/3)

- Read the proposed topics and any comments/indications from the Professor carefully
- Thoroughly evaluate your research interests and skills
 - How well do they align with the Professor who proposed the topic?
 - Do I have the technical (e.g., quantitative) skills necessary for a topic identified by the Professor as quantitative/empirical?
 - How consistent are the topic and research methodology with my career path and goals (e.g., working in a company, pursuing a PhD)?
 - Am I familiar with the topic?
 - Why am I choosing it?

Tips - How to Relate to Your (Potential) Supervisor (2/3)

- Once you have answered these questions and selected your topic, prepare for your first meeting with the Professor
→ never select a topic before discussing it with the prospective Supervisor!
- Prepare your thesis proposal to discuss with your potential Supervisor:
 - research question
 - thesis objective(s)
 - research methodology
 - theoretical framework / (preliminary) reference literature
 - draft table of contents / index

Tips - How to Relate to Your (Potential) Supervisor (3/3)

- Of course, every Professor manages the relationship with students differently, and it will be up to your Professor to show you how to work once she/he starts mentoring you ... but **being prepared and proactive is key!**
